The Basics

- Contest opens NOW through November 2, 2009.
- Open to all students, in grades 9-12, participating in the 2010 TEAMS Competition.
- Individual and team entries will be accepted. More than one entry may be submitted.
- All designs must be emailed to teams@jets.org using subject heading "TEAMS T-shirt."
- Submitted entries must include the following:
 - ⇒ Design (Read "The Guidelines").
 - ⇒ Indicate individual or team entry.
 - ⇒ Name(s) of student(s) involved in design.
 - ⇒ Name of high school, city and state.
 - ⇒ Phone number and email of TEAMS Coach.

The Guidelines

- Design must focus on an aspect of engineering related to "Water, Water, Everywhere."
- Design must completely fill an 8.5 x 11 letter-size paper.
- Design may be hand-drawn or computer-generated.*
- Maximum of 4 colors may be used.
- Artwork must be submitted with 300 DPI or higher resolution.

Acceptable File Formats:

Any files using Adobe Illustrator, Macromedia Freehand, CorelDRAW
Submit file in EPS format with ALL text converted to outlines.
JPEG, TIFF, Publisher (saved as high resolution PDF).

Hand-drawn Artwork:

Art must fill the entire 8.5" x 11" sheet of paper.
Acceptable mediums are markers, ink, or acrylics.
Must be converted to a JPEG or TIFF file (300 DPI).

GIF, PNG, Word, PowerPoint, or other web ready, low resolution art will NOT be accepted.

The Disclaimers

- Designs will be judged based on creativity, originality and relevancy to theme.
- Artwork is subject to modification due to potential printing and restrictions of file formats.
- Odds of winning depend on the number of entries submitted.
- All expenses incurred with the design of the artwork are the responsibility of the contestant(s).
- Artwork or content deemed inappropriate by JETS for purpose of contest (offensive in nature or irrelevant to theme) will not be considered for final judging.
- All submissions become property of JETS and contestant(s) must agree to the unlimited use of his/her name(s), school/group and design for use by JETS for promotional and publication purposes without compensation.
- Artwork should be original. Contestant(s) take all legal responsibility for trademark infringement or unauthorized use of copyrighted or trademarked images.
- Entries submitted after November 2, 2009 will not be considered.
- All decisions by judges are final.
